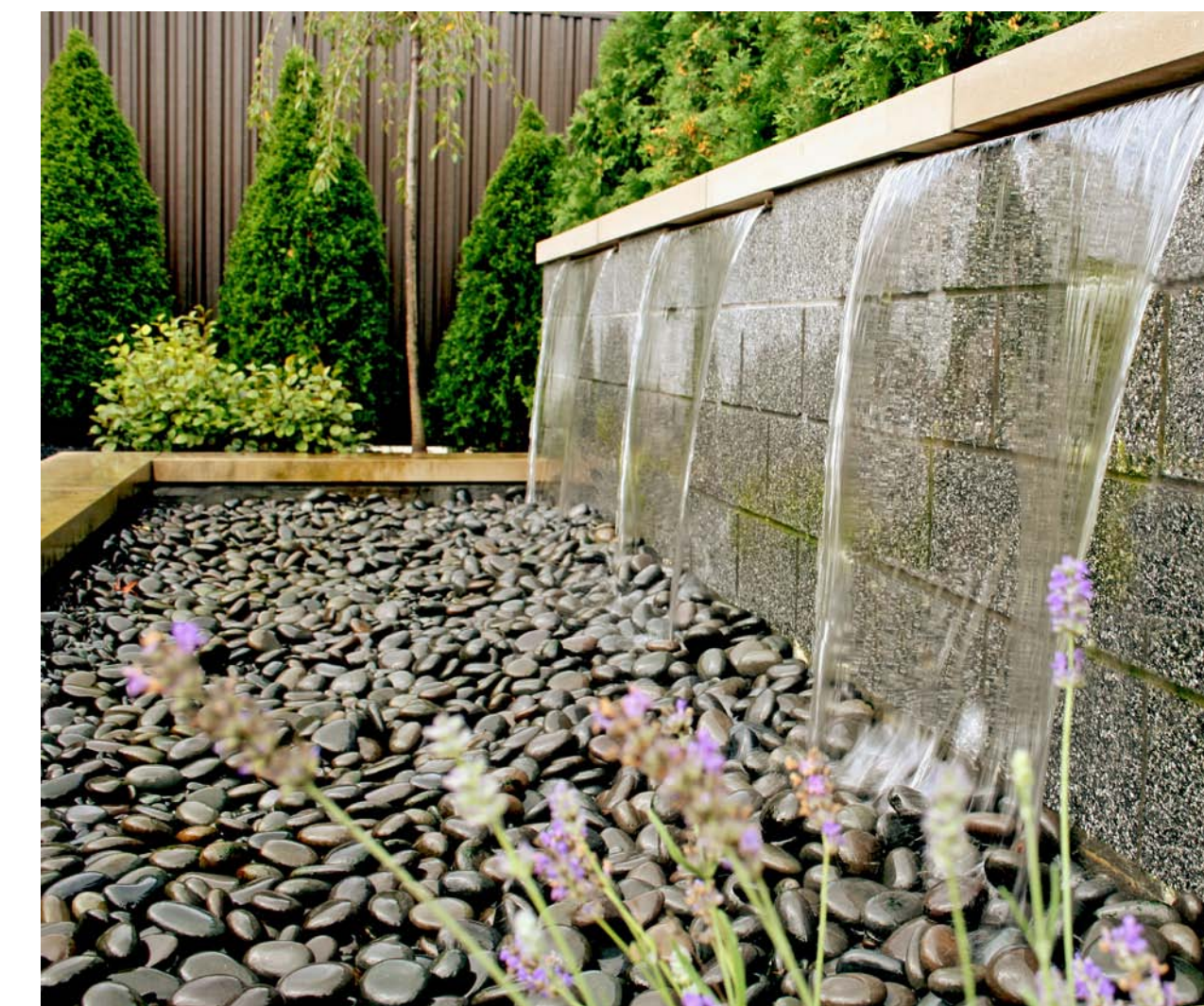


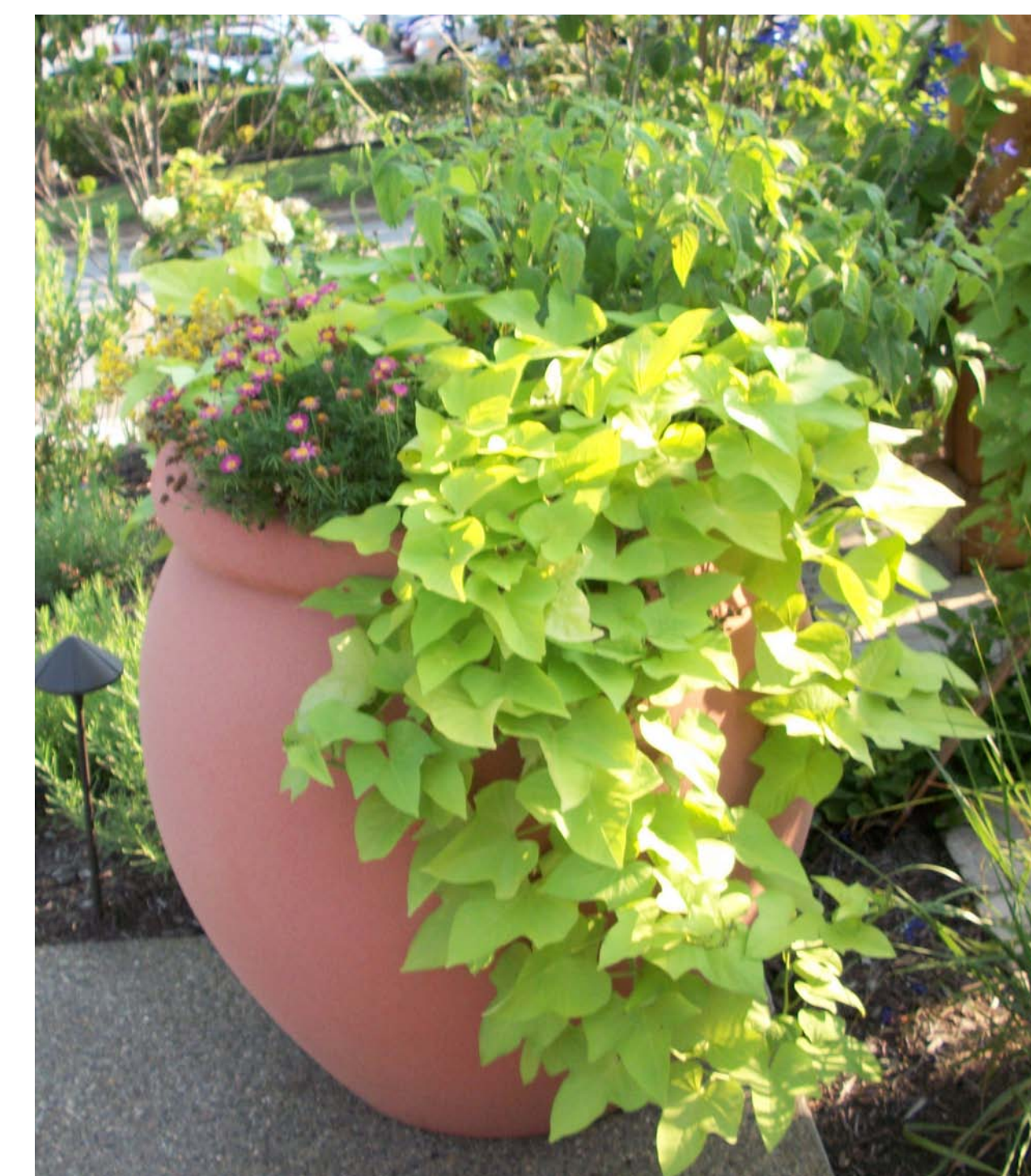


UPMC St. Margaret Garden of Hope

A community effort, this garden was supported by local garden clubs, physicians, board members, employees, community members and patients.
